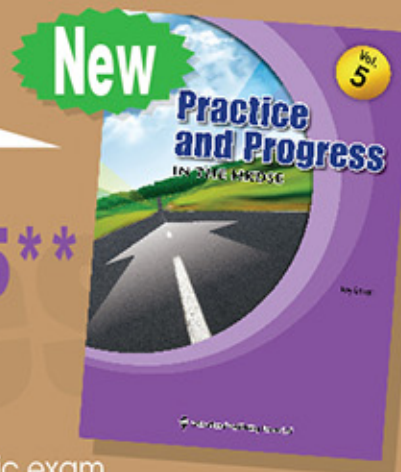
Video recordings for Paper 4 Group Discussion
